
### Pour-in-Place Window Installation guide




# Step 1

Unlock the latches and pull off ties.




## Step 3

Place at desired height and level.




# Step 5

REINSTALL ties. Lock the latches.




### Step 2

Slide down base into forms.



### Step 4


Screw or nail all around in the wooden frame on both sides. Screw/nail on wooden brace PERIMETER only.



### Use nails included with the frame.

### Step 6

Pour the concrete according to the recommended method.



# Pour-in-Place Window 2<sup>nd</sup> method (optional for big sized windows)




### Step 1

Unlock the latches, pull off ties and remove the inside panels where the window will be fixed.



### Step 2

Place the base at the required height and level it.



### Step 3

Carefully remove the protective film. Nail through the inside perimeter of the wooden brace. Stick back the film.




Reinstall formwork panels, reinsert the ties and lock the latches.



Use nails included with the frame.

### Step 5

Screw or nail through formwork in the bracing. Make sure to find out exactly where it's located to avoid any damage to the base.



# Step 6

Pour the concrete according to the recommended method.
